

Registration of Boiler under the J&K Boilers Act, Svt. 1991.

A. Procedure for registration:

1. An applicant submits application along with boiler folder containing certificates of manufacture and test of all Boiler mountings and fittings, drawings, specifications and prescribed fee in the office of Inspector Boilers.
2. On receipt of an application, the Inspector fixes a date within 45 days for the examination of the boiler and the notice is given to the owner thereof not less than 10 days, notice of the date so fixed.
3. On the said date the Inspector proceeds to measure and examine the boiler and to determine in the prescribed manner the maximum pressure at which the boiler may be used, after conducting Hydro and Steam tests on the boiler. The boiler inspection report along with the boiler folder and MR book is submitted to the Chief Inspector in the prescribed form.
4. The Chief Inspector on registering the boiler, issues certificate to the owner in the prescribed form authorizing the use of the boiler for a period not exceeding twelve months at a pressure not exceeding such maximum pressure as he thinks fit.
5. The Inspector conveys to the owner of the boiler the orders of the Chief Inspector and therewith issue to the owner certificate of which the issue has been ordered.

1. Application for registration
2. Boiler folder containing certificates of manufacture and tests of all Boiler mountings and fittings.
3. Drawings of boiler and steam pipe line.
4. Layout of steam pipe line.
5. Certificate of Competency of boiler attendant.
6. Submission of Welder's qualification certificate approved under IBR 1950.
